Who is eligible?

How do I apply?

First, email your resumé and a one-page proposal outlining your research project to ndnano@nd.edu by **June 8**. Be sure to include your name, university, email address, research adviser's name, engineering or science discipline, and planned month/year of graduation.

Then, by **August 15**, email a PowerPoint file recapping your research findings, along with a recommendation letter from your adviser. Up to 12 finalists will be selected and invited to present their findings at a one-day event at Notre Dame in the fall (date TBD).
