Dodgeball Tournament

Wednesday, January 30 • 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

The Tournament:

- Anyone a part of the Notre Dame and South Bend communities can form a team and participate in the tournament.
- Teams consist of 6-8 players. Only six can play at one time, but extra players will act as substitutes.
- Teams are asked to raise a minimum of \$30 in order to enter the tournament, although we encourage teams to raise as much money as they can. Money will be collected during team check-in on the day of the tournament. Members of the team that raises the most money will each receive a small prize.
- Each team will play one game at a predetermined scheduled time. Depending on the number of teams, we will either do a traditional tournament style (play until you lose) or two of the top teams will be selected to play in the final round.
- Schedules and a copy of the rules will be emailed to the team captains the day before the tournament (Tuesday, January 29).
- The winning team of the final round will be honored during the Notre Dame Women's Basketball game on Saturday, February 2nd.
- There will be a costume contest to see which team can wear the most **pink**. The members of the team that wins this contest will receive a small prize.
